REFLECTION

What a funny thing pruning is—at least to a nongardener like me. Cutting a plant back to make it grow goes against everything you would expect. But we know it works.

Today Jesus talks about His Father pruning us by means of the word Jesus has spoken. And I guess we all feel the cut of that pruning knife from time to time. Jesus' teachings challenge us—or, at least, they should. He sometimes calls us to do things we don't find easy or pleasant or convenient, and sometimes calls us to renounce things we might enjoy—to take up our cross daily and follow Him.

And then we can be tempted to do a bit of pruning ourselves—to prune Jesus' teachings! We can be tempted to cut away all the things we find difficult and challenging and just keep the agreeable parts. But then we face a question—who are the better gardeners: you and me, or Jesus and His Father? Who knows best how to make a branch as fruitful as possible? Who knows best how to avoid a branch withering, becoming fruitless and only being fit for firewood?

Jesus loves to think of us as His fruitful branches, remaining in Him and He in us, being His disciples and giving glory to His Father. And we love that thought too. If we keep His word in our lives, it won't be just a lovely thought but a living reality. Fr Stephen
