"Ephphatha," said Jesus as He touched the deaf man's ears—"Be opened." It is one of the few occasions when we hear the actual Aramaic words spoken by Jesus. Others include *Talitha, kum* (Get up, little girl) as He raised Jairus' daughter from the dead; *Abba* (loving Father) as He prayed in agony to His Father in the garden of Gethsemane; and *Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?* (My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me?) as He died on the Cross. Almost certainly they indicate real eyewitness (earwitness!) reports. Undoubtedly they indicate moments of great importance.

Ephphatha—Be opened. It's not just about the miracle of curing a deaf man. It's the attitude Jesus wants us all to have. So often after teaching something important Jesus concludes, "If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear." What's the point of teaching if your pupils are not listening? And of course, it's not just physical ears that need to be open; most of all it's the ears of our hearts. We need to let Jesus' teaching penetrate to the depth of our being with all of its power to convert and transform.

When a baby is baptised, the minister touches the ears and mouth of the child, saying, "The Lord Jesus made the deaf hear and the dumb speak. May he soon touch your ears to receive his word, and your mouth to proclaim his faith." The ceremony is called *Ephphatha*. May it be true for each of us, today and every day.
