There is already a Catholic lay chaplain appointed to the team who I will work with closely. He will take the lead in the pastoral care. Please pray for this work.

Fr Tony Lovegrove (& Jake!) will supply Masses on the weekends of 16th/17th and 23rd/24th. At coffee after 10am Mass on Sun 10th Nov I propose to provide some bubbly to mark the half century.

DURING NOVEMBER, for the remembrance of the faithful departed, I will give priority to the general mass intention 'Holy Souls', and continue this into Advent when I return.
