What's the key to today's Gospel about the woman caught in adultery? I think it is that Jesus turns a situation about group dynamics and challenges into one about individuals and relationships.

It starts off with scribes and Pharisees—in the plural—no one taking individual responsibility for what is going on. They make the woman stand in full view of everybody. They refer to her as "such women". She is just a statistic in their eyes.

Jesus' reaction turns the dynamic upside down. First of all He remains silent and bends down—turning His face away from the bullying group. And He takes things to the individual level: "Let *him* who is without sin among you be the *first* to throw a stone at her." And it has a clear effect: they go away *one by one*, and Jesus is left *alone* with the woman. And there, in the gentleness and compassion of a truly interpersonal encounter, He pronounces His forgiveness: "Neither do *I* condemn *you*; go, and from now on sin no more."

Our own healing encounter with the Lord's mercy is also personal—one to one. It has to be, because it is a meeting in love, and love is always personal. That's why the Lord wisely and lovingly gave us the sacrament of Reconciliation, so He can say to each of us individually, personally, "Neither do I condemn **you**. Go and sin no more."
