REFLECTION

In His discourse on the Good Shepherd (John 10:1-18) Jesus makes two comparisons. The first is between the Good Shepherd and the thief:

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

The second is between the Good Shepherd and the hired man:

The hireling ... abandons the sheep and runs away as soon as he sees the wolf coming ... because he has no concern for the sheep. I am the Good Shepherd; I know my own, and my own know me ... and I lay down my life for my sheep.

From this double comparison we can learn something of the delicate art of true, Christ-like loving. As so often in the Christian life, the aim is to find the perfect balancing point between two mistaken approaches. In this case the vices are possessiveness in loving on the one hand (the "thief") and half-heartedness or lukewarmness on the other (the "hireling"). As always, the vices are rather easy: selfishness, being controlling or even manipulative on one side; and on the other, being a fair-weather friend who doesn't really care, and just makes excuses when difficulties arise. As always, the balancing act of virtue between the opposing vices is somewhat more challenging—but beautiful, holy, lovely and life-giving: generous, wholehearted, self-giving service and love.
