#### **OPEN AIR MASS SUNDAYS 10AM**

The forecast for Sunday is fine but chilly so wrap up warm! Looking at the long range forecast, it's possible this will be our last outdoor Mass of the season, but a decision will be taken about that next week. Check the website, newsletter or church doors for updates.

Should Mass not be possible for any reason then a simpler liturgy or prayers will be offered.

Maintain social distancing, use hand sanitiser, and follow the directions of the stewards or Fr Charles. Please bring your own chair or groundsheet if you want.

Face-coverings are welcome, but not required outdoors. Those concerned about the risk associated with receiving Holy Communion are still welcome to attend and make a Spiritual Communion instead.

While we are legally exempt from the new 'rule of six' this only applies for the Mass itself, and a reasonable gathering and dispersal time before and after. Beyond this the rule of six does apply. Please don't rush for the exit (this could lead to congestion at the gateway), but please don't hang around too much either. Also, any combined family groups attending and sitting together cannot be more than six.
