REFLECTION

Jesus talks today about being lifted up: "The Son of Man must be lifted up as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert." In fact Jesus uses the phrase three times. (We'll hear another one next Sunday). It's a powerful image. Think how much little children love to be lifted up; think about celebrating with a sports trophy. Being lifted up speaks to something very deeply engrained in our human nature. But being lifted up can also have negative connotations: think about being held up as an example (not to be copied) or being held up to ridicule.

Jesus' being lifted up includes all of this. It's His being lifted up on the Cross to be mocked, to suffer and to die—and to save us from our sins. But it's also His glorious Resurrection and Ascension into heaven.

In the liturgy too Christ is lifted up with powerful symbolism. On Good Friday the crucifix is solemnly lifted up three times for our veneration. At the Easter Vigil the newly lighted Easter Candle is also lifted up three times in honour of the Risen Jesus. And at Mass—most lovely of all—day by day at the consecration Jesus is literally lifted up in the sacred Host and the precious Chalice; and we glory in His Cross and His risen presence among us. We bow down in worship, and He draws us all to Himself.
