From Fr Charles

The weather forecast for Sunday morning is fine and sunny. An outdoor Mass will be attempted at 11am.

It is perfectly acceptable to attend Mass, make a Spiritual Communion, and not receive Holy Communion if you feel it's too great a risk.

Next Sunday our Mass or Liturgy will be outside at 11am, or simply cancelled if the weather is not good.

I am working towards the weekend of 13th/14th March (4th Sunday of Lent, and Mothering Sunday) to restart Mass in the Church, with our normal schedule Sat 6pm, Sun 8am and 10am. The option will be retained to hold the 10am Mass outdoors if the weather is good. Directives on how we will handle the Holy Week and Easter services have not yet been received.

The church will remain open for private prayer at the usual times Sat 10-12 and Wed 2-4. Votive lights will not be available. The audio podcast Mass will continue unchanged. The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended.

Attending a place of worship is a valid legal 'excuse' for being outside your home during lockdown, and therefore making a reasonable journey to get there. Please note, if you choose to attend Mass in another parish you may need to book in advance.
