Dear Sisters and Brothers

O Dear! Some more of those "hard sayings" of Jesus today! What to make of them?

I suppose the first thing to say is that Jesus really did mean them. He said those things and said them in that way to confront us with our lazy listening and pre-conceived ideas about things. He wanted us to listen, to be outraged, to be challenged and then think deeply about these things. For us, today, of course, we have heard them before and so, to some extent they have lost their power to shock and challenge in quite the same way. But if we place them alongside the words of the opening prayer "that those who believe in Christ may receive true freedom and an everlasting inheritance" we may begin to perceive the key to unlocking their meaning.

If you read someone like Thomas Merton in his book Seeds of Contemplation you will notice that he bangs on constantly about detachment – all the spiritual masters do. Detachment isn't to think of everything as unnecessary or as rubbish, or as corrupting but, instead to hold everything in its right context and relationship. To see everything as a gift and not my possession which can end up meaning "possessing me". To be truly detached from worldly things is to hold them in gratitude and to be able to say to our God and Father "Thank you – all things come from you, and of your own do we give you". (1 Chronicles 29:13-15). Yes, even our mothers and fathers, our wives and children are all gifts of a generous God. We don't possess them, and neither should they possess us, but all are gifts of a generous and loving God to be accepted with gratitude. Enjoy Mass today and give thanks for all those who make it happen and beautify it for us.
