There is something wonderfully joyful about the response of Peter and his friends to Jesus' call. Their spontaneity and courage are exciting—even inspiring—if just a little bit scary too. It's youthful and vigorous rather than being careful and measured. Maybe it's the way the Church ought to be. Maybe it's the way each of us ought to be as we hear Christ's life-giving message.

To understand those disciples' response to Jesus' call properly, I think we need to combine what Matthew tells us with what John says at the beginning of his Gospel—some of which we heard last week. The point is, this is not the first time Peter and his gang have met Jesus. They had been disciples of John the Baptist, and John had pointed out Jesus as “The Lamb of God”. So they start to follow Jesus along the road, and get into conversation with Him, and Jesus invites them to spend the rest of the day with Him. They may even have seen some of Jesus' first miracles.

Now Jesus is asking them to take the next step: not just to enjoy time in His company, but to become His disciples—not just to follow along the road, but truly to be His followers in mind and heart. And He holds out to them where that will lead, that is, to becoming fishers of men. A little bit scary? Yes, I guess so. Vigorous, joyful, courageous, exciting? Yes, certainly. Inspiring? Yes, definitely. So, shall we follow their example, and follow Jesus?
