#### **LENT 2025**

We begin the Season of Lent on Ash Wednesday. For 40 days we suspend normal activities so as to focus on the key themes of the season: prayer, fasting, almsgiving as well as reconciliation, penitential services, preparation for the sacraments of initiation and acts of charity.

#### <u>Prayer</u>

On Wednesday 5th March, **Ash Wednesday** we gather for Mass and the distribution of ashes, which will take place at 10am in the Cathedral and 7.30pm at Storrington.

**The Poor Clares at Crossbush** will be holding a Lent Group every Thursday from 6th March 3-4.15pm, all welcome.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available at the usual times and places throughout Lent: Thursdays from 10.30 to 11.30am at Storrington, and Saturdays from 10.30am to 11.00am (or longer if there are still people waiting) at Arundel. In addition there will be a deanery Reconciliation Service with Bishop Richard at the Cathedral on Wednesday 2 April at 7.00pm.

In Holy Week Confessions will be available:

- Holy Tuesday 15 April at Storrington from 10.30 to 11.30am
- Maundy Thursday 17 April at Arundel from 10.30 to 11.30am

- Good Friday 18 April at Arundel after the Celebration of the Passion (so starting around 4.30pm)
- Holy Saturday 19 April at Arundel from 10.30 to 11.30am

You can also find times and places for Confession at other nearby parishes via their websites. Finally, you are very welcome to make an individual appointment with Fr Stephen.

**Stations of the Cross—Arundel** will take place every Friday at 7pm alternating between the Cathedral where we begin this week—7th March, and St Nicholas' Church. All are welcome.

- Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> March a one-off collection for the National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham to support Jubilee Initiatives and projects at the Shrine.
