This Wednesday 28 May is the 60th anniversary of the creation of our diocese of Arundel and Brighton. It is also the 10th anniversary of the installation of Bishop Richard. The diocese is our "local" or "particular" Church—like the Churches in Rome, Corinth, etc. that St Paul wrote his letters to. The Bishop is celebrating a special Mass on Wednesday in the Cathedral at 12 noon. Everyone is welcome to come along. It would be lovely to have a great crowd to swell the celebration.

The Second Vatican Council teaches us: The Roman Pontiff, as successor of Peter, is the perpetual and visible source and foundation of the unity both of the bishops and of the whole company of the faithful. The individual bishops are the visible source and foundation of unity in their own particular Churches, which are constituted after the model of the universal Church; it is in these and formed out of them that the one and unique Catholic Church exists. (Lumen Gentium 23)

The relative youth of our diocese reminds us that while divinely instituted realities (like the universal Catholic Church) remain for ever, human realities can come and go. And this flexibility is a gift of the Holy Spirit, a sign of the vitality of the Body of Christ and its ability to respond to the changing needs of the mission. We live in a time of great change—indeed, as Pope Francis said, not so much in an era of change as a change of era. As the feast of Pentecost draws near, we ask as a diocese, as parishes, and as individuals, to be open to this dynamic of the Spirit making us ever new.

Changes to Mass times and Confirmation season When Confirmation Masses are taking place on a Saturday, the 10am morning Mass will move to 9am, with no Exposition or Benediction but Confessions will still be available after Mass. Saturday 24th & 31st May will be at the earlier time of 9.00am. Also, this coming week marks the 60th Anniversary of the Diocese and the Cathedral Chapter are celebrating with Mass at 12 noon on Wednesday (no 10am Mass). All are welcome.

Ascension Day is this coming week on Thursday 29th May. Masses will be at 10am in the Cathedral, 11.30am at the Convent at Crossbush (not 8.30am), and 7.30pm in Storrington. This is a Holy Day of Obligation.
