"My son, you are with me always, and all I have is yours." These are the loving father's words to his elder—non-prodigal—son in Jesus' parable. The son shares everything that is the father's, and most especially his presence. There is no more wonderful expression of love than to be with the beloved.

This is really important to Jesus and to His heavenly Father, for the idea crops up again and again in the Scriptures. It is the answer in the book of Job. After all his sufferings (losing all his possessions, children and health) the righteous Job encounters God, and all his complaints give way to reverential silence as he says, "I knew you then only by hearsay; but now I have seen you with my own eyes." Psalm 73 gives the same answer when the righteous man complains about how well the wicked do. He finally reflects, "Even so I stayed in your presence; you held my right hand; my joy lies in being close to God."

It is the heart of the message of Christmas: Jesus is Emmanuel, which means 'God is with us'. It is Jesus' deep desire at the Last Supper: "I have longed to eat this Passover with you before I suffer." It is His earnest plea to His disciples in Gethsemane: "Could you not keep awake with me one hour?" It is His reassuring response to the repentant thief from the Cross: "I promise you, today you will be with me in paradise." It is His solemn promise at His Ascension: "I am with you always; yes, to the end of time." It is the meaning of the whole Christian life. It is heaven.

Today, the Shrine attracts some 150,000 pilgrims during the pilgrimage season, with about 35 major pilgrimages from Catholic dioceses, parishes, societies and associations. Walsingham is a great Marian Shrine of the Incarnation and a place of pilgrimage for all who would rejoice with Mary at the great joy of the Annunciation.
