If only the whole people of the Lord were prophets, and the Lord gave His Spirit to them all! This is the prayer of Moses in today's first reading. And that prayer was answered (more than 1000 years later) at Pentecost, when God sent His Holy Spirit onto the Apostles. And we all receive the same Spirit at our Baptism and Confirmation. So **we are all prophets**.

This doesn't mean that we can predict the future! Rather, it means that we are called and empowered to speak God's word—to say "Thus says the Lord", as all the Old Testament prophets did. So we speak out for justice and for mercy, to call to conversion and speak God's words of consolation, to proclaim the Truth and Good News of Jesus Christ with courage and humility and joy—not relying on our own abilities, but on the Holy Spirit really dwelling powerfully within us.
