In November the whole Church unites in special prayer for those who have died, and have "gone before us with the sign of faith." (Eucharistic Prayer 1)

As Christians, we know that death is not the end. The central truth of the Gospel is that "Jesus died and rose again, and that it will be the same for those who have died in Jesus." (1 Thess 4:14) We even dare to echo St Paul's sentiments in his letter to the Philippians: "To me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain ... My desire is to depart and be with Christ, for that is far better." (Phil 1:21,23)

We also know that we are not yet worthy of so great a gift—to see God face to face in heaven and be with him for ever. In all honesty, we are not fully ready for heaven: our love of God and of each other is not yet perfect. To imagine that we are ready for heaven seems to cheapen the tremendous gift that God is offering us. So we give thanks to God for the wonderful and mysterious gift of purgatory, by which he completes his work of preparing us to be with him for ever in perfect joy.

We also thank God that we can help one another through purgatory by our prayers—especially by offering the Mass for them—and by our works of penance and charity. It is our great duty, privilege and consolation to pray for our own loved ones and for all souls in need, and it is our hope that others will one day pray for us.
