

Am I the light of the world?

When it's dark and we want to be able to see, the answer is easy. We flick a switch and on comes the light. In a trice everything becomes visible. Faith can be like that but sometimes it can take time – maybe a long time – for the light of our faith to grow in strength and intensity. We shouldn't worry about how long it takes but rejoice that it is happening at all. Because even the faintest light illuminates the darkness. We see that in the night sky.

We might be tempted to try and hide ourselves away because we are nervous about letting the light of faith into our daily lives. We can't really do this because God still sees us. For him, darkness is not dark and the night is as clear as the day (Psalm 139). Allowing Jesus, the light of the world, into our lives, is such a help to us. He helps us to recognise that the parts of our personality that trouble us actually drag us down. We know that when we criticise and talk negatively about other people we are harming ourselves as well as, perhaps more than, them. He invites us to shift the focus of the light away from ourselves, avoid being paralysed by our inadequacies, and look instead at the people around us who long for welcome, acceptance, enough to sustain them.

Responding to someone in need strengthens their faith as well as our own. Maybe people look at us and wonder why we do what we do, why we are how we are. But if they they're not looking, and if they're not wondering, what does that say about the light of Christ we are supposed to be?
