MASSES IN CHURCH THIS WEEKEND

Masses in the Church:

Saturday 6pm and Sunday 8am and 10am. Please bring a face covering unless exempt. Entry into the church may take longer than usual so please arrive in good time.

The Stewards will be assisting everyone with hand sanitising, showing people to socially distanced seating, and keep a note of the households attending in case of track and trace needs. Please follow their guidance, and note that to make best use of space you may not be seated in your 'usual spot'.

Use of the kneelers is optional and at your own risk; it is not possible to sanitise the fabric surface, but the risk is judged to be very low.

The toilets will only be available for emergencies.

More volunteer stewards and cleaners are needed from ALL three weekend Masses. These Masses cannot continue without this.

The weekday afternoon 'church open for private prayer' has moved from Tuesdays to Wednesdays, 2-4pm. Saturday morning 10am-12noon remains unchanged. Please follow the directions of the Stewards.
