Last week we heard the theme of mission in the readings, and it crops up again this week. The risen Jesus asks Peter three times, "Do you love me?" and each time, when Peter says he does, Jesus replies with a mission: "Feed my lambs ... look after my sheep ... feed my sheep."

In fact, pretty much every time the risen Jesus appears to someone, He sends them out on mission. To the women at the empty tomb He says, "Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee". The two disciples in Emmaus who recognise Jesus in the breaking of bread return immediately—although it's the middle of the night—to share the good news with the disciples back in Jerusalem. Last week we saw Jesus saying to the apostles in the Upper Room, "As the Father sent me, so I am sending you." And finally, meeting the apostles on the mountain in Galilee before His Ascension, He gives them the great commission: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

So I wonder: what is the risen Jesus saying to us? What is our mission in Arundel and Storrington in 2025? Please do pray frequently that we will listen to—and hear—and respond with courage—to whatever He says!
