Mary's Meals would like to invite you to collect all your foreign currency* no matter how old or obscure. There are envelopes at the back of church for you to take home and put all your foreign coins and notes into. Please bring them back to the church for sending off in early September. Clear out your drawers and have a look under the sofa, talk to friends and neighbours, maybe they have spare foreign coins/notes as well? Currently the charity feeds over 2.4 million young children one good meal every day in their place of education – by giving Mary's Meals your foreign coins and notes you can help feed the next hungry child. *We will also take UK coins/notes that aren't legal tender.

CCRS – South – beginning Tuesday 24 September 2024 – Fee payable The CCRS (Catholic Certificate in Religious Studies) will be run at Cardinal Newman School in Hove on Tuesdays from 3.45-5.45pm.
