Over the next five Sundays we will be reading chapter 6 of St John's Gospel, all about Jesus as the Bread of Life. This week we start with the feeding of the 5000. That certainly gets people's attention! They're so excited that they want to force Jesus to become king! But over the next few weeks Jesus unfolds the true meaning of that miracle. He leads us away from focusing on earthly bread—things that only satisfy our bodily and worldly desires—and points us to the true Bread of Life—Himself. He is claiming to be the source of our real happiness and fulfilment, the source of everlasting life. It's a big claim!

And the more He unfolds this mystery, the more He focuses on His gift of Himself—His true flesh and blood—as our Bread of Life in the Holy Eucharist. And the more He does that, the more the crowds change from their initial excitement to being shocked and scandalised: "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Only Peter and a few faithful disciples will remain committed to Jesus as the crowds walk away.

It's a pattern we see in our own society: once so committed to Christ, now faith in Jesus and commitment to His Eucharist are in sharp decline. Seemingly only a few of us remain faithful like Peter. But Jesus didn't change His teaching to fit in with the expectations of the crowd. And after Jesus' Resurrection, Peter and the faithful few preached the Gospel to the whole world. We too must remain totally committed to Jesus in the Mass, and He will do wonderful things for us and through us as well.


