Jesus opens his mouth...

Jesus has begun his ministry. Called the first disciples. Walked throughout Galilee teaching and healing. The word has spread. Now crowds of sick and disabled throng and follow him. They're light years away from comfort and wealth, status and power, the traditional trappings of happiness, of God's blessing. The 'have nots' are his audience as he dismantles society's misconceived understanding of what being 'blessed by God' means.

The allure of having power and wealth is so strong. We find them difficult to resist. Jesus rejects them. They are shallow and illusory and can be removed as quickly as they are given to us. Jesus teaches us to focus on quality rather than quantity. The word of God is always a fresh invitation to us to change to be people possessing and displaying purity of heart, generosity of spirit, and showing mercy. Blessedness is a state of being, not having.

When we live the Beatitudes in every aspect of our lives, we find what we're really looking for: the inner spiritual peace that flows from being in a right relationship with God. We find that our eyes are opened to the needs of everyone around us, within our families and our local community. And we are inspired to minister to them.

Jesus opens his mouth, and teaches us. Let us pray for the grace to hear and respond.


