TODAY IS A DAY FOR LIFE Celebrated annually by the Catholic Church in this country it is a day dedicated to raising awareness about the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. The proceeds of the Day for Life collection today will be used for the promotion of the dignity of the human person through the distribution of grants. This year the focus is on domestic abuse. One in four women and about one in six men suffer from domestic abuse in their lifetime. Two women are killed every week in England by a partner or ex-partner. Domestic abuse is often a hidden problem, and the aim of the church is for anyone experiencing domestic abuse to feel able to have confidence to seek help within the Church setting.
